

GETTING TO ALL SAINTS' COFFEE LOUNGE, HALE BARNs.

The Coffee Lounge is part of the All Saints' Hall complex which is up a driveway running round to the back of the church from the A538 in Hale Barns. Bus 18 has stops at All Saints Church, and runs to Hale Barns (in opposite directions) from the railway stations at both Manchester Airport and Altrincham.

BY RAIL

You need to decide whether to book to Altrincham or to Manchester Airport.

If you are likely to be on the 08.20 from London Euston, or joining it en route at Milton Keynes (08.50) or Stoke-on-Trent (09.48), you should change at Stockport and book to Altrincham.

You should also book to Altrincham to arrive by 10.50am if you are travelling via Chester, from where there is a through service, or from the Sheffield area via Stockport.

If you are coming from West or North Yorkshire, the North-East or Cumbria you should change at Manchester Piccadilly and book to Manchester Airport to arrive by 10.40am. From some places you may be lucky enough to find a through train!

If you are not covered by any of the above categories, you will probably find that you will have to stay over on the Friday night. There are reasonably priced rooms still available at the time of writing at the Travelodge in Altrincham and at the Premier Inn at Manchester Airport. The rail station to which you book will depend on where you are spending the Friday night.

ALL MEMBERS APART FROM THOSE TRAVELLING BY CAR

Buses (route 18 towards Altrincham) leave Manchester Airport station at 10.18 and 10.48. From Altrincham (route 18 towards Trafford Centre), they depart at 10.25 and 10.55. We will make every effort to meet the 10.46 train arrival from Stockport with a car.

If you hold an English bus pass, please bring it with you as it will be valid on the service 18.

Taxis are of course also available in the event of late running etc.
